Review Commission and to Authorize the Codifier of Rules to Make Rule Technical Corrections, to Clarify that a Party May Commence a Contested Case in a Dispute with an Agency Without Petitioning the Agency for Rule Making or Obtaining a Declaratory Ruling, and to Revise the Process for the Review and Readoption of Existing Rules, as Recommended by the Joint Legislative Administrative Procedure Oversight Committee.
